- **Enhance:** Proposals that support improvement in existing school programs and/or staff development (e.g. professional development or consulting services to support existing work in the school, expansion of an existing program, etc.)
- **Innovate:** Proposals that support the development of new programs that have been identified to enhance the school's ability to serve its students and increase academic and life outcomes\* (e.g. research and plan for the implementation of a new program, professional development, pilot phase of a new program, etc.)
- **Explore:** Proposals that support initiatives to help inform the school's strategic direction and capacity to improve student academic and life outcomes\* (e.g. consulting services to support exploration or planning phase, strategic planning, research to determine feasibility and strategic fit of a potential school-wide initiative or expansion project, etc.)

\* *What is a "life outcome?" A life outcome may refer to, but is not limited to, any of the following:*

- *Postsecondary credential (e.g. certification or degree)*
- *Development of character and personal traits contributing to postsecondary success*
- *Development of a non-academic skill (e.g. career technical education, professional skills, etc.)*
- *Enrichment opportunities that lead to enhanced opportunities beyond high school*

### **BUDGET**

**Tier 1 grant proposals can request up to \$225,000 per year, depending on the number of students directly impacted by grant funds:**

- <100 students directly impacted: up to \$100,000 per year
- >100 students directly impacted: up to \$225,000 per year

*These guidelines are intended to be general parameters, with a correlation between funding amount requested and number of students directly impacted by the grant funds. It is most critical that the proposal makes a compelling case as to why the requested amount of money is necessary, regardless of number of students directly impacted. For example, a school with a proposal that will directly serve 90 students can apply for a grant in excess of \$100,000, if there is strong justification to warrant it.*

Tier 2 grant proposals can request up to \$100,000 per year.
