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Individual Schools Grants

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- Support improvement and enhancement efforts in Kansas City area K-12 schools in order to:
 - Build upon existing programs
 - Launch new programs, bring new ideas and approaches to the school
 - Explore to help inform the school's strategic direction
- School leaders identify a challenge or opportunity → propose a solution → apply for funding

Individual Schools Grants

- Since 2015, \$4.9 million awarded to 23 school projects, including:
 - 12 district schools in 7 Kansas City area districts
 - 6 charter schools
 - 3 private schools
- Detailed information at: rfp.kauffman.org

- Applications due **February 12, 2019**
- Notifications by March 15, 2019

Individual Schools Grants

- Examples of past recipients
 - Expansion of New Americans program
 - Piloting a co-teaching model
 - Building capacity around college counseling
 - Planning to transform into a Community Schools model
 - High school redesign
 - Implementing trauma-informed care practices
- Focus on a comprehensive approach
- Funding is not available for facilities/construction costs or replacement funding



Eligibility

Individual Schools Grants

- Eligibility

- K-12 district, charter or private school
 - If private, school must be a 501(c)(3)
- At least 40% of students qualify for free/reduced price lunch
 - If private, at least 40% of students qualify for financial assistance
- Located in the six-county KC Metro area
 - MO: Cass, Clay, Jackson, Platte
 - KS: Johnson, Wyandotte
- Academic criteria, as follows

Individual Schools Grants: Tier 1

- Elementary and Middle Schools
 - Within 10% of the state average on the state assessment in English Language Arts and/or Math
- High Schools
 - School's four-year graduation rate **AND** average ACT score is within 10% of the state average
- May apply for up to **\$225,000** per year, up to two school years

Individual Schools Grants: Tier 2

- Does not meet academic criteria for a Tier 1 grant, but:
 - (2a) School has newer instructional leader (first three years at the school) with proven results
 - (2b) High school meets one but not both of the performance benchmarks (i.e. graduation rate or ACT) - OR -
 - (2c) School leader has successfully participated in either School Retool or Kansas City Leadership Cohort
- May apply for up to **\$100,000** per year, up to two school years

Outputs and Outcomes

Outputs and Outcomes

- Outputs

- Key activities or deliverables to be completed
- What will you/your school/staff do directly?
- Maximum of 10 outputs (but 10 not required)

- Outcomes

- Major indicators of success specific to the program/project funded
- What is the expected impact or positive changes that will occur as a result of the project
- Maximum of 5 outcomes (but 5 not required)

Outputs and Outcomes

- All metrics should include 5 key components:
 1. **WHO** will complete the output or be the beneficiary of the outcome?
 2. **WHAT** is the activity or result expected to be achieved?
 3. **BY WHEN** will it occur?
 4. **HOW MUCH** will be done or accomplished (i.e., a numerical target)?
 5. **HOW WILL WE KNOW** the result was achieved?

Outputs and Outcomes

- Example Output #1

By May 2020 (BY WHEN), ABC School (WHO) will create and implement a uniform scope and sequence for ELA (WHAT) for all grade levels (HOW MUCH), as demonstrated by the ABC School scope and sequence document (HOW WILL WE KNOW).

- Example Outcome #1

“By May 2020 (BY WHEN), the percentage of students meeting their reading growth goals (WHAT) will increase by 5 percentage points (HOW MUCH), as measured by NWEA MAP assessment report (HOW WILL WE KNOW).
(2018 baseline=55%)

Outputs and Outcomes

- Example Output #2

By **December 2019** (BY WHEN), **ABC School** (WHO) will host at least **10 hours** (HOW MUCH) of **professional development focused on XYZ** (WHAT), as demonstrated by **agendas and sign-in sheets** (HOW WILL WE KNOW).

- Example Outcome #2

By **May 2020** (BY WHEN), at least **85%** (HOW MUCH) of **teachers participating in the XYZ professional development** (WHO) will **implement learned skills and strategies to improve XYZ** (WHAT), as measured by **lesson plans and administrator observations** (HOW WILL WE KNOW).
